City of Parksville Property Taxes Due July 2

2024 tax notices will be mailed to property owners this week. If you do not receive your property tax notice by June 10, please phone the City at 250 248-6144. Payments must be received and homeowner grants must be claimed by the due date of July 2 to avoid a penalty. All eligible homeowners are required to apply for their homeowner grant with the Province of BC at *gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant* or by phone at **1 888 355-2700**.

When making a payment at a bank or through online banking, please allow a minimum of two business days for bank processing time. Regardless of your payment method, payment must be received at the City of Parksville by the due date of Tuesday, July 2 or be subjected to an immediate 5% penalty. An additional 5% penalty will be applied to current year property taxes outstanding at the end of business on September 16. Penalties are also applied to any unclaimed homeowner grants.

The 2024-2028 financial plan, tax rates and utility rates bylaws were given final adoption by Council in May. The bylaws reflect a 6.6% increase in general municipal property taxes, a 5% increase in metered water and water parcel tax rates, and a 3% increase in sanitary sewer usage and parcel tax rates.
