

BC Hydro Streetlight Replacement Program for Parksville

At the February 17 meeting, Parksville Council approved the installation of 3000 Kelvin LED streetlights as part of BC Hydro's program to replace all existing high-pressure sodium streetlights with new LED streetlights on wooden poles leased to the City.

The contractor for BC Hydro, J E Electric, will begin replacement the week of March 8 with completion by the end of March. While this work is underway, the public may experience short-term traffic or pedestrian detours or delays. Vehicles as well as pedestrians will be directed by traffic control persons. We ask that you be patient and slow down while travelling through work zones.
