Business licences and dog licences expire December 31 and are due by January 31. Renewals will be mailed to residents and businesses once the Canada Post disruption is concluded. In the meantime:

Business Licences - Business owners may obtain their renewal invoice from City Hall administration during regular business hours (8 am to 4 pm, Monday to Friday). Business owners may also email biz@parksville.ca for a copy of the renewal. Fees which remain unpaid after January 31 will be subject to fines. A late fee of \$50 will be applied on February 1 and every thirty days to any outstanding licences. Direct questions to biz@parksville.ca or 250 954-4650. For payment options, refer to the City's website.

Dog Licences - Tags must be purchased in-person from City Hall during normal business hours or from BCSPCA (Tuesday to Saturday, noon to 4 pm). All dogs over the age of six months must wear a municipal dog tag, renewed yearly. Cost for dog licences when paid by January 31, spayed/neutered \$20, not spayed/neutered \$30. After January 31, spayed/neutered \$25, not spayed/neutered \$35.
